



William A. Haseltine

William A. Haseltine PhD has an active career in both Science and Business. He was a professor at Harvard Medical School and Harvard School of Public Health from 1976-1993 where he was Founder and the Chair of two academic research departments. He is well known for his pioneering work on cancer, HIV/AIDS and genomics. He has authored more than 200 manuscripts in peer reviewed journals and is the author of several books. He is the Founder of Human Genome Sciences, Inc and served as the Chairman and CEO of the Company until 2004. He is also the Founder of eight other successful biotechnology companies. He is a Partner in Ashmore India Asset Management Ltd, a private equity asset management company, a member of the Reliance Industries, Ltd Innovation Council, India and an advisor to several biotechnology and pharmaceutical companies.

William A. Haseltine is currently the President of the Haseltine Foundation for Medical Sciences and the Arts, a foundation that supports access to high quality health for the poor and middle class of developing countries, primarily India, the foundation also fosters a dialog between sciences and the arts. He is the Chairman of Haseltine Global Health, LLC, a company dedicated to creating new and more efficient means to develop new life saving drugs and medical devices. He is an Adjunct Professor at The Scripps Institute for Medical Research and the Institute of Chemical Engineering the University of Mumbai, India, and is a Trustee of The Nimagadda Foundation, India He is also active in the field of renewable energy. He is Chairman of the Board of the Berkeley Center for Synthetic Biology and a Director of The Solena Group, Inc.

Dr. Haseltine is active in public service. He is Co-Chair of the President's Council of the Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory, and is a Governor of the New York Academy of Science. He is an honorary member of the Board of Trustees of the Brookings Institution, a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, and a Patron of the Asia Society.

He resides in Washington DC and New York City.
